Optimal Medical Therapy

It is essential that patients in both treatment arms receive optimal medical therapy (OMT) to test the added value of revascularization. This includes monitoring LDL cholesterol and blood pressure. Please review monthly site-specific OMT reports (new reporting frequency, new design to focus on participants not at goal).

Drug Donations

Thanks to generous donations from AstraZeneca, Merck and Arbor Pharmaceuticals, Canadian patients participating in the ISCHEMIA trial have access to free rosuvastatin (Crestor), ticagrelor (Brilinta), and nitrolingual spray. We hope to have ezetimibe (Ezetrol) available soon as well!

Please consider these for your patients, especially those who don't have insurance; it will help to achieve OMT!

Don't forget to consider any patient with stress echo-determined moderate-to-severe ischemia who doesn't have significant obstructive disease on CT angiography for CIAO!

To enhance enrollment for CKD, connect with your nephrologists to recruit patients on dialysis and/or on a renal transplant list.
