

What To Do In The Event Of A Crossover

For participants assigned to the conservative management (CON) strategy, avoidance of unnecessary cardiac catheterisation (Cath) is critically important to protect the ability to test the study hypothesis.

The CON strategy permits Cath only for participants who fail optimal medical therapy (OMT), i.e. those who experience a nonfatal myocardial infarction, resuscitated cardiac arrest, hospitalisation for unstable angina or heart failure, or who have angina that is refractory to medical therapy. Elective Cath for any other reason is a protocol violation. As per appropriate use criteria for stress imaging, investigators should not perform routine stress tests for the purpose of monitoring ischemia in patients who are clinically stable. Strategies to prevent crossover are not directed toward patients who have experienced a suspected ACS.
