When Do We...?

Some data items are easily missed! Below is a list of commonly missed data items and when they should be collected.

Blood Pressure - Every Visit Heart Rate - Every Visit Weight - Every Visit

<u>Medications</u> – Assess at every visit <u>Hospitalizations</u> – Assess at every visit

<u>Standard Lab Results</u>- Every visit except for 1.5M and CCTA visits <u>Creatinine</u>- Every 12 months after RAND visit (CKD ONLY)

You may also contact the participants' GP or check other sources that may have the information.

For a full breakdown of required study related activities, be sure to check the *Schedule of Assessments* (available on page 42 in version 2.0 of the protocol)!

What Does This Mean?! ISCHEMIA Edition

<u>Standard Labs</u>— Include lipid panel (preferably fasting), HbA1c (diabetic patients only), Liver transaminases (if indicated), full blood count, and chemistry panel.

QOL Forms:

Full Baseline Questionnaire — 7 Pages (Rand Visit)
Brief Symptoms Questionnaire — 2 Pages (1.5M Visit)
Full Follow-Up Questionnaire — 5 Pages (12M, 24M, 36M, etc.)
Brief Follow-Up Questionnaire — 2 Pages (6M,18M, 30M, etc.)

Complete Ischemic Revascularization:

PCI− revascularization of all vessels ≥2.25 mm resulting in ischemia via noninvasive imaging or FFR.

CABG- grafting of all areas of significant ischemia based on preoperative testing or FFR of intermediate lesions at diagnostic catheterization and revascularization. of areas subtended by occluded coronaries unless the myocardium is demonstrated to be nonviable.
